FINAL DETERMINATION FOR AERONAUTICAL FEES AND CHARGES BY AIRPORT FIJI LIMITED

Date of Report: 30 SEPTEMBER 2010

1.0 BACKGROUND

Following the release of the determination on fees and charges for Airport Fiji Limited (AFL) on 7th April 2010, the Commission received a new submission from AFL on 5th July 2010 requesting for a review of the previous determination.

On 15 September 2010, the Commission also received a written submission from the Association of South Pacific Airlines (ASPA). On the same day a meeting between the representatives from ASFL and ASPA was also conveyed by the Commission at the Commission office and the views and grievances from both parties was noted.

On 16th September, 2010 the Commission wrote to Airports Fiji Limited to provide the Commission with the following:

- Capital Investment Commitments for the next five years with clear timelines indicating the date of completion.
- 2. Board papers outlining the approval for these projects signed by the Chairman.
- All programmes intended to be introduced by Airports Fiji Limited in order to improve the economic efficiencies of all services provided by it,

The Commission in a letter dated 17th September signed by the Chief Executive Officer and Chairman of Airports Fiji Limited received the following in response to the request by the Commission.

- 1. Capital Investment Commitments for three and half years commencing mid 2010 to 2013.(Annexure 1)
- Confirmation that AFL is currently in the process of preparing the three year Corporate Plan from 2011 to 2013 as a requirement under the Public Enterprise Act. AFL has indicated that this plan will be approved by the Minister of Public Enterprises in the first quarter of 2011 and the draft and final copy of this plan will be forwarded to the Commission in the due course.
- 3. The Commission is invited to verify the CAPEX papers on site.
- On the issue of the economic efficiency programme, of Airports Fiji Limited indicated the following:
 - Engagement of consultants to carry out a Job Evaluation Exercise.
 - Engagement of an audit firm for the development of the Enterprise Risk Management framework and to carry out internal audits on each process to ensure to policies and procedures and also to improve the processes.

2.0 FIJI COMMERCE COMMISSION AUTHORISED CHARGES

Noting the submissions from of Airports Fiji Limited and the Association of South Pacific Airlines (ASPA) and the Capital Investment Commitments by Airports Fiji Limited the Commission undertook the review of the authorised charges of the first determination released on 7th April, 2010. After analysing the Submissions from AFL and ASPA and through its independent computation and research, the Commission has authorised the following charges to be effective from 1st October, 2010:

1. Air Navigation Charges

The air navigation charge is also called En-route charge which is applied to all aircrafts flying in Nadi Flight information Region (FIR), whether landing or not.

AFL stated¹ that with the introduction of a proper user pay charging system, the En route services fee would reduced by 18% to eliminate the cross subsidy between the FIR and the Terminal Area Service unit fee will be revised down.

5. Aerobridge Charge

The aerobridge charges will be abolished from 1 September 2010.

The above authorised aeronautical fees and charges are subject to the following conditions:

- The fees and charge authorised by this Determination may be revoked or varied by the Commission in the event of any material change in government tariff or economic policy;
- ii. The fees and charges authorised by the Commission may be revoked or varied in the event that AFL failed to make material disclosure to the Commission:
- The fees and charges authorised by the Commission may be revoked or varied in the event that the Commission considers upon a review that changed circumstance warrant a revocation or variation;
- iv. The determination of prices for the new aeronautical charges will be fully effective until 31 December 2011.
- v. AFL is required to furnish to the Commission Certificate of Completion of the projects completed from mid 2010 to December 2011 and other supporting documentation for its capital investment work in progress as per the appendix listing by 30 November 2011. The Commission will then determine the new aeronautic fees and charges to be effective from 1st January 2012. In the similar token Certificate of Completion and other supporting documents must be provided by end of November 2012 to determine new fees and chargers for 2013.
- vi. Airports Fiji Limited (AFL) must not introduce any new charges of vary any authorised charges without the Commission's approval.
- vii. Airports Fiji Limited (AFL) must supply to the Commission the report of the Job Evaluation Exercise and its plan of action to effect the recommendations from the report. AFL is also required to provide evidences of implementations of the recommendations from this exercise.
- viii. Airports Fiji Limited (AFL) must provide to the Commission the draft and final copy of the three year corporate plan as indicated in their letter dated 17th September, 2010 by not later than the first quarter of 2011.
