

COMMERCE ACT 1998

(Act No. 50 of 1998)

Commerce (Control of Prices of Interconnection Services Rates) Order 2009

PURSUANT to section 32 of the Commerce Act 1998 ('Act') and after having considered a recommendation by the Commerce Commission declare that the prices for goods or services specified in this Order are controlled in accordance with the Act and I make the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order is cited as the Commerce (Control of Prices of Interconnection Services Rates) Order 2009.

Interpretation

2. For the purposes of this Order "Interconnection" has the meaning given in section 36K of the Act and "Interconnection Services" means any wholesale service provided or offered by any person in relation to Interconnection.

Price Control

3. For the purposes of Section 32 of the Act, the prices or rates for the supply of Interconnection Services in all quantities and qualities, grades or classes are controlled.

Expiration of Order


4. This Order expires three years from the date this Order is made unless it is varied, extended or earlier revoked.

Minister's Decision not to be challenged

5. (1) No court, tribunal, commission or any other adjudicating body shall have the jurisdiction to accept, hear, determine or in any other way entertain, any challenges whatsoever (including any application for judicial review) by any person or body, or to award any compensation or grant any other remedy to any person or body, in relation to the validity or legality or propriety of any action or decision of the Minister or the Commerce Commission in making this Order.

- (2) No court, tribunal, commission or any other adjudicating body shall have the jurisdiction to accept, hear, determine or in any other way entertain, any challenges whatsoever (including any application for judicial review) by any person or body, or to award any compensation or grant any other remedy to any person or body, in relation to the validity or legality or propriety of any action or decision of the Minister or the Commerce Commission resulting from the making of this Order.
