Senior Market Analyst - Transport (Ref No: 06/21)

The incumbent will be responsible for carrying out market research, analysis, and monitoring of regulated transportation industry by FCCC while monitoring new developments and making recommendations to the relevant policy changes. The incumbent will also be required to achieve objectives specified in the Strategic Plan, by ensuring regulatory compliance with the FCCC's key performance indicators and the administration of the work under the FCCC Act 2010 relating to Economic Regulation and Transportation sector. Assistant Market Analyst - Energy (Ref No: 08/21)

The incumbent will be accountable to monitor trade & commerce in Fijian Market. The incumbent will also assist with day to day rent market inspections and suggest strategies to improve overall trade compliance in the Fijian market. The applicant with a Degree in any business discipline with 2 - 3 years or above relevant experience in the areas of price monitoring, handling of consumer complaints will be considered. Candidate must have experience in the area of price control, analysis of financial statement, market surveillance and people management skills. Inspector – Technical Regulations (Ref No: 11/21)

The incumbent will be required to perform electrical inspections for licensing purpose as and when required by FCCC in accordance with the Electricity Act 2017 and enforce compliance according to FCCC Act 2010 if required. The Incumbent will be required to carry out inspections for both commercial and residential buildings while ensuring good safety practices are followed and conformance to specifications as detailed and meets quality standards. While working closely with the Economic Regulations team, the incumbent will be required to record acceptance or rejections while conducting inspection and maintain statistical information of electrical inspections carried out, monthly progress reports and other required reports relevant for the purpose of FCCC's decision making. This unique career opportunity requires applicants to at least possess a Bachelor of Electrical Engineering or equivalent and be a licensed electrical inspector with atleast 5–6 years of industry experience. Applicant shall possess exceptional supervisory and excellent organizational skills. Applicant with knowledge of FCCC Act 2010, with a valid driving license will have an added advantage. Monitoring Officer - Regulations (Ref No: 12/21)

The incumbent will be accountable to carry out monitoring activities for the regulated markets in Fiji. The applicant will be responsible to enforce the provision of the FCCC Act 2010, by carrying out routine regulated industry inspections and surveillance activities while creating awareness. The Incumbent will be also required to conduct regulated industry surveys to collect data, investigate complaints, benchmarking activities and handle day to day tasks as assigned and suggest strategies to improve overall compliance in the Fijian regulated market. The applicant will be working closely with the Manager Economic Regulations, to conduct monitoring activities that are part of the Strategic Goals of FCCC. The incumbent will also have to keep up to date with and understand, FCCC Act 2010, policies, and regulations of FCCC and monitor compliance in the Fiji Market.
