

ADVISORY COVID-19 Operational Update TUESDAY 18 May 2021

Since 20 April 2021, a total of 1,170 inspections have been conducted covering the Central, Western and Northern Divisions.

102 inspections of the total 1,170 were completed on Friday, 14 May 2021 with 2 inspections in the Central Division, 26 inspections in the Western Division and 74 in the Northern Division.

The inspections included 50 for Stock & Supply Surveillance and 52 for COVID-19 Safety Measures.

All 52 traders inspected for COVID-19 Safety Measures were found to be practicing safety measures when inspected.

While reviewing domestic supply chains, logistics disruptions were noted in the delivery of sugar was found across several supermarkets. FCCC provided assistance in making arrangements with the Fiji Sugar Corporation and respective traders in an effort to normalise supplies.

Since the implementation of COVID-19 safety measures by the Fijian Government and the Ministry of Health and Medical Services, teams from the Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission (FCCC) have been on the ground conducting inspections for stock and compliance with COVID-19 safety measures.
