The Fijian Competition and Consumer Commission (FCCC) is an independent statutory authority whose role is to enforce the FCCC Act 2010; promoting competition and fair trading, regulating prices in markets where competition is lessened or limited, and regulating monopolistic market situations including national infrastructure for the benefit of all Fijians.
