FCCC Checklist for Applying for Ownership of or Proprietary Interest in Pharmacy Business: Eligibility:

- Are you a registered pharmacist owning no more than 5 pharmacy businesses?
- Is your company registered with all directors/shareholders being registered pharmacists and owning no more than 5 pharmacy businesses?
- Are you a lawful partnership with all partners being pharmacists?
- Are you an approved pharmacist with 5 existing pharmacies, seeking approval in an underserved area?
- Are you a licensed private hospital authorised by the health minister to own a pharmacy business?

Application Requirements:

Written application:

Include clear details of the applicant and proposed pharmacy business.

Written declaration:

- Commit to participating in the Government's Free Medicine Programme.
- Confirm no unauthroisaed activities on the premises.
- Disclose any criminal convictions or misconduct by the business, directors, officers, or employees (if company).
- Submit a copy of the partnership agreement within 2 months (if partnership).

FCCC inspection:

- Ensure the premises comply with suitability and other prescribed requirements.
- Guarantee the facilities, equipment, security, management, and operation adhere to good pharmacy practice and other prescribed requirements.

Renewal:

Submit a renewal application to FCCC at least one month before expiration.
